Early divisions and groups

The group names in the synonymy of many of the earlier daffodils in the Register are listed below. They were part of a scheme of classification drawn up by the Royal Horticultural Society's Daffodil Conference of 1884 when "New Daffodils" as opposed to the species were brought under review for the first time. It was resolved that these and all future new garden varieties should carry "fancy" names in the modern language, not pseudo-botanic names in Latin form.

The newly named daffodils were listed in groups and di
