### DIVISION 4 - DOUBLE DAFFODIL CULTIVARS

One flower to a stem; corona ("trumpet") as long as, or longer than the perianth segments ("petals") One or more flowers to a stem, with doubling of the perianth segments or the corona or both

## DIVISION 2 - LARGE-CUPPED DAFFODIL CULTIVARS

One flower to a stem; corona ("cup") more than one-third, but less than equal to the length of the perianth segments ("petals")

### DIVISION 5 - TRIANDRUS DAFFODIL CULTIVARS

Characteristics of N. triandrusclearly evident: usually two or

DIVISION 3 - SMALL-CUPPED DAFFODIL CULTIVARS

One flower to a stem; corona ("cup") not more than one-third the length of the perianth segments ("petals")

# DIVISION 7 - JON UILLA AND APODANTHUS DAFFODIL CULTIVARS

Characteristics of Sections Jonquilla or Apodanthi clearly evident: one to five (rarely eight) flowers to a stem; perianth segments spreading or reflexed; corona cup-shaped, funnel-shaped
